Are you up to date in PECOS?

What is PECOS?

The Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System (PECOS) is the electronic Medicare enrollment system. PECOS is the source of truth with CMS for ACO participation. Unfortunately, the Scripps ACO does not have the access or authority to update your PECOS information.

What do you need to do?

ACO participants need to keep their provider enrollment information up to date, including the addition and deletion of any ACO providers billing through the Tax Identification Number (TIN) of the ACO participant.

Please notify Scripps ACO within 30 days of enacting any changes in PECOS. Annually, ACO participants will be asked to review and certify the accuracy of the data in PECOS.
