Subject: ACO Master Participation Agreement

Action Required: All ACO practices will be required to sign an amendment to the ACO Master Participation Agreement via DocuSign by APRIL 30, 2022.

The ACO Master Participation Agreement encompasses both ACO products (Medicare Shared Savings Program and Qualcomm Premier Plan) and was signed by all participating practices upon joining the ACO.

This document is up for renewal and will be emailed to each practice in the form of an amendment via DocuSign the week of April 11. All participating ACO practices will be required to electronically sign this document by **April 30, 2022**. Please note, <u>if not completed by the deadline, your practice</u> will be at risk for termination from the ACO.
